Dear Parents

Houses on Arthurs Lane

You will all be aware that the Council has passed plans to build new houses in Hambleton. The Directors of Fylde Coast Academy Trust are keen for you all to know that at both school and Trust level, we will do all in our power to work with Lancashire County Council, and the developers to ensure that there are enough school places for all Hambleton children, requiring primary education now and for years into the future.

Lancashire County Council had initially named Stalmine School as the intended school to use the education contribution to provide additional primary places. This has now changed to Hambleton because it has been agreed to land transfer extra land for an additional school playing field, to enable Hambleton Academy to furnish an expansion program to accommodate additional school places. The Local Authority keeps this money until the need arises. If this means that school has to expand then we will approach this in a measured way, consulting with all stakeholders.

Hambleton Primary Academy will not be in any receipt of funding from the developers.
